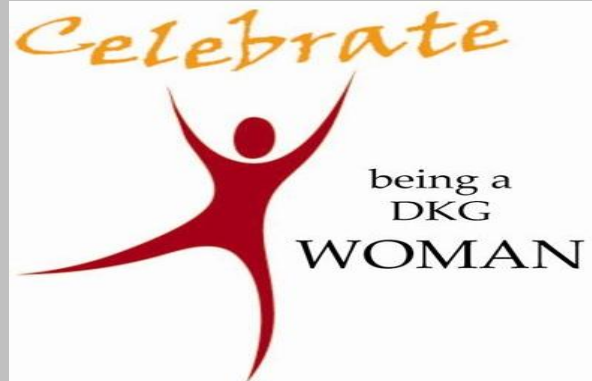
NEW MEMBERS
